1. Welcome

So nice to see everyone again and have another lively & enthusiastic discussion.

2. Minutes from 17th November 2017.

Agreed as correct by everyone via email prior to the meeting.

3. Filmhire, venue, date & publicity.

Agreed that GTG would hire the film from the Transition Towns network at the rate of £100. The Magic Lantern cinema are allowing us to use their venue for a community screening with standard ticketing rates. In the event that the ticket sales do not meet the hire cost then members of the GTG planning group have agreed to meet the difference. Proceedings from ticket sales in excess of £100 may be kept by the cinema to help meet their associated costs for heating, staffing & publicity. The film will be on Sunday 21st January as a matinee performance at 2pm & it will be listed in the cinema programme.

AP: RG to confirm with A from Transitions Towns network that J, Magic Lantern can book the film on behalf of GTG.

AP: SW to liaise film booking with J.

We will record people's reactions to the film in the foyer after the film to create "vox pop" videos to go on our website & the Transition Towns network website. We hope that we will have interviews where people respond in English & Welsh. AP: LH & 1 other.

Tea, cake & chat after the film to encourage people to complete #onegreenchange tag for the tree & register their interest in joining GTG. AP: Contributions of home-made cake requested.

We will hold an "After Tomorrow" event as a follow-up to the film – date to be confirmed at the next planning meeting in January. We discussed the White Hall pub as a potential meeting place but nothing was decided.

We are allowed to promote the Tomorrow film at the Bruce Parry event on Sunday 33rd December. We will write a bilingual letter introducing GTG & the film for handing out at the cinema.
